

# Public Notice

## Iowa Department of Natural Resources

Notice is hereby given that the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) has under review an application for amended Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) air quality construction permits. The permit application was submitted by University of Northern Iowa (UNI) located at 1901 West 30<sup>th</sup> Street, Cedar Falls, Iowa 50614.

Based upon the information provided by the applicant, IDNR has determined that UNI is a "major stationary source" for the PSD program. The permit application has met the requirements of 567 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) Chapter 33. The emissions from the facility (IDNR AQB facility ID 07-02-006) will not contribute to a violation of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) nor exceed the PSD increment consumption threshold.

This project is for a proposed modification that will allow the installation and operation of a steam injection system for the operation of Boiler #3 combusting Natural Gas.
